QUESTIONS

1. Moses records the LORD saying in Leviticus 11:44 “I am the LORD your God; consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am holy.” Holiness can mean many different things to different people. Take some time and share from your background, experiences, and understanding what the term ‘Holy’ or ‘Holiness’ means to you, especially in a practical daily life sense.

2. The above Scripture, roots our holiness in God being Holy. We believe that God is intrinsically holy. This is not a common word we use in our vocabulary on a daily basis. It basically means to be set apart or to be separate. Millard Erickson says there are two aspects we should understand when we speak of God being holy*. The first is His uniqueness. Please read the following verses and discuss what they reveal about God. Exodus 15:11; 1 Samuel 2:2; Isaiah 57:15 and Isaiah 6:1-4.

3. The second aspect of God’s holiness (according to Erickson) “is His absolute purity and goodness.”* Please look up the following passages and then discuss not only what they mean, but how we are to live before a holy God and live before other people. James 1:13; Job 34:12; Matthew 5:48 and Isaiah 6:5.
