Saints of God Covered in Mud - October 3, 2021

1 Corinthians 1:4-9 - 'Everything You Need'

## QUESTIONS

Read 1 Corinthians 1:4-9. Considering all the issues the church has – isn't it amazing how Paul is so incredibly confident in remembering all that this church truly 'is' and 'has' spiritually? He's full of thanksgiving for what is true about them – before they change, adjust, or repent of anything.

1. Do you know (or have known) anyone in your life who has this mature spiritual attitude towards people? What was their impact?

2. **Taking a Spiritual Thanksgiving Inventory:** In your own personal life – what can you give God thanks for that He has done in you? Take some time with this – pray and ask God to help you see where His grace and gifts given to us have been evident.

In our church life – what can you give God thanks for? What has He done in us as a church? Same thing, let God show us His grace and gifts given to us, where it has been evident.

Consider Ephesians 3:18, 19; Colossians 2:9-10; 3:3; 2 Peter 2:3 – Do we realize what our spiritual resources truly are? Time for a 'treasurers update' of what Christ has given us! What keeps us from seeing one another (and one another's future in Christ) the way Jesus sees us?

**Bonus Exercise:** For fun, read Revelation 7:9-17. Try to think of all the people that you will see and worship with one day. Think and discuss with a friend or a small group about how big and diverse that community will be, considering the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ.
