Saints of God Covered in Mud - November 21, 2021

“Who Lights the Fire of Faith?”

1. From 1 Corinthians 2:6-16, there are statements about the Holy Spirit, about God, and about how as people we can understand things. What do we learn about God here? What do we learn about people?

2. Consider that Paul is still in the middle of a part of his letter dealing with a quarreling church. How can appreciating the work of the Holy Spirit make a difference, the next time we are faced with the temptation to quarrel?

3. If the Holy Spirit is responsible for anyone's genuine encounter with God: in what way is that a great comfort? In what way is it an incentive to pray and live a Christ-revealing life? In what way is it a challenging mystery?

4. If truly knowing God is only possible by the work of His Holy Spirit – this is obviously more than just gaining more information! How do we make sure we are not defaulting to just ‘information’ and ‘debate’ when we have questions for God or about God?

Bonus: What is the connection between ‘learning’ and ‘worshipping’ for the life of the believer in Jesus?
