Saints of God Covered in Mud - February 6, 2022  
"Warning & Deception"

1. How comfortable are you with telling the 4-chapter gospel? Can you think of all four without looking? Try this with your small group. Next step – can you think of where you can find a scripture passage example to fit with each chapter?

2. In a rebellious time in life, I remember wondering "what can I do and get away with and still be a Christian?" Why does the question itself reveal a turning of the heart in the wrong direction? Has that question ever been yours? What changed?

3. Why do we naturally become easygoing with some sin, and with other sin we are shocked? What are the dangers of this? What is the antidote for this way of thinking?

4. Since Christ deliberately and compassionately washes, sanctifies, and justifies shocking sinners like us (6:11) - how can Christian friends support one another through experiences of great internal challenge? What can our church do to be a good place for those seasons of incredible temptation? How do we keep from acting 'holier than others?'

5. In evangelical churches, communion is often treated as a very private, personal experience. However, the Bible shows us that it is a 'together' or 'corporate' experience. Reflect on the group aspect of communion – what is significant about us remembering Christ's sacrifice together instead of by ourselves?
